#### R-12 | Traffic Reminder & School Safety

As the school year commences we take the opportunity to remind you about keeping our community safe. For those of you who are new to our community particularly, please take the time to read this information. Ensuring our driver and pedestrian behaviour is safe and appropriate is imperative for the safety of your child, other children, other road users and our neighbours, who we work with continuously to ensure they are not impeded by our regular movement times.

#### Some key messages:

- Above all be patient and courteous particularly to those who may be new to Nazareth and taking time to navigate their new surroundings.
- We encourage 7 12 students in particular to explore alternative methods of arriving at school bus, bikes, even walking
  from a few streets away. These options will save you time and lessened stress.
- Adhere to traffic and parking signage it's there to help us effectively manage busy times.
- Kiss and Drop lines must be moving vehicles should not be stationary for more than 2 minutes

We have staff on duty until 3:30pm at Findon and 3:45pm at Flinders Park – come a little later, the lines move much faster then!

#### Year 3-7 | Ongoing Sacramental Preparation 2022 & 2023

At Nazareth, our Sacramental Program has a two-year cycle, parents/caregivers have the option to extend this further if they wish. Families with students who have prepared and celebrated First Reconciliation in up to 2022 and enrolled in the 2023 Confirmation and First Eucharist Program were emailed about the Parent Information Meetings which began earlier this week.

# Year 4 | CyberSafe Families Parent Information Night

Children in Year 4 will be receiving a laptop as a tool for their learning. An integral part of Nazareth's Laptop Agreement requires parents/caregivers and students to attend a Cyber Safety information session presented by Cybersafe Families.

The student session will occur during school hours and will cover:

- Skills that encourage young people to be good digital citizens
- · Ways for students to conduct themselves online safely and respectfully
- Guidance on how to have positive online experiences

The Parent/Caregiver session will take place on Monday 20 February in the MacKillop Hall, from 6:30-8:00 pm.

This session will provide strategies to make the home environment cyber safe. It is important to fully understand both the opportunities and the threats that the online world present, and to be equipped with the knowledge about the best practices available to protect your family. This is a fantastic opportunity for you to learn more about young people and the online environment, and how you can help your child to be a safe and responsible use of technology.

This is a compulsory information session that at least one adult member of the family must attend (unless you have a child currently in Year 5 at Nazareth) so that your child can begin taking their laptop home. Should you not be able to attend this session, it will be necessary to attend a make-up session.

- Wednesday 29 & Thursday 30th March diphtheria, tetanus, whooping cough vaccine (Boostrix) and human papillomavirus vaccine. Gardasil 9
- Wednesday 22nd & Thursday 23rd November 2nd dose of human papillomavirus vaccine, Gardasil 9

#### Dates for Year 10 Students:

- Wednesday 7 June Meningococcal ACWY and Meningococcal B
- Wednesday 30 August Meningococcal B

Immunisation consent packs will be distributed by the Mentor Teachers.

If you want your child to be vaccinated but not at school, they can attend the City of Charles Sturt clinic to receive the free vaccines.

### 10-12 | Work Experience

#### **Work Experience Process:**

The Work Experience Form must be filled out and submitted to the Career and VET Coordinator to process 2 weeks before the Work experience placement can take place.

1. Students that would like to undertake work experience as either part of their VET course or to find an appropriate career pathway are to download the Workplace Learning Agreement form via E-NAZ, Student Links, Careers Website (second document via the link here). Or email Claire Dodman.

Once the paperwork is completed by the student and host company the WLA forms can be taken to Student Services at the Flinders Park Campus to be signed for approval by the Principal or Deputy Principal.

#### Before the work experience takes place

- 2. The Career and VET Coordinator is required to undertake a Risk Assessment to ensure the safety of the student. The host business is contacted to discuss the placement and/or any issues that might arise in the risk assessment.
- 3. All parties must receive a completed copy of the:
- Workplace Learning Agreement form
- Worksite Risk Assessment Form

Before placement can commence (the Student, Parent/Carer and Host company).

- 4. The student is responsible for emailing their Teachers/House leader to inform them when and where the placement will occur.
- 5. The Careers and VET Coordinator will visit all students on work experience and is available to do this in the **first week of each** school holiday or through the school term.
