



R-12 | SEQTA Engage App

SEQTA Engage is Nazareth's Learning Management System which will enable you to view the following information in relation to your child:

- 1. Attendance information, with the ability to contact the school through to internal messaging system to resolve any unknown absences.
- 2. Assessment results and feedback from teachers.
- 3. Past student reports.
- 4. College news and events.

For parents of students returning to Nazareth in 2023, you can choose to use this email to reset your existing password, or ignore the email and continue to use your existing details. These login details will not change from last year unless you change them.

For new parents, or parents who have not yet logged into SEQTA, please follow the instructions contained in the email sent to you today to set up your account. Note that you can use a username and password of your own choosing.

You can access the SEQTA Engage portal in two ways:

- 1. Via a web browser using the link https://parents.nazareth.catholic.edu.au, or
- 2. Via the SEQTA Engage app for Android/iOS devices. Download these apps using the links in the welcome email or use the Google Play Store (Android) or Apple App Store.

The mobile app requires iOS 12.0 or later (Apple) and 5.0 and up (Android) software to be compatible with your device. Please ensure the software on your mobile device is up to date.

Children in Year 4 will be receiving a laptop as a tool for their learning. An integral part of Nazareth's Laptop Agreement requires parents/caregivers and students to attend a Cyber Safety information session presented by Cybersafe Families.

The student session will occur during school hours and will cover:

- Skills that encourage young people to be good digital citizens
- · Ways for students to conduct themselves online safely and respectfully
- · Guidance on how to have positive online experiences

The Parents/Caregivers session will take place on Monday 20 February in the MacKillop Hall from 6:30-8:00 pm.

This session will provide strategies to make the home environment cyber safe. It is important to fully understand both the opportunities and the threats that the online world present, and to be equipped with the knowledge about the best practices available to protect your family. This is a fantastic opportunity for you to learn more about young people and the online environment, and how you can help your child to be a safe and responsible user of technology.

This is a compulsory information session that at least one adult member of the family must attend (unless you have a child currently in Year 5 at Nazareth) so that your child can begin taking their laptop home. Should you not be able to attend this session, it will be necessary to attend a make-up session.
