The annual tuition fee has been billed to your account and statements (along with the College Financial Information for Families for 2023 booklet) were posted out this week.

#### 2023 Other Student Charges

Other student charges such as music instrument hire, academy fees, co-curricular sport etc will be billed after April 2023 and may continue to be added to your account throughout the year.

#### When are fees due to be paid?

All fees are required to be paid on a regular basis (weekly or fortnightly) and must be paid in full by 10 November 2023. Direct debit by BPAY is the College's preferred payment method.

Families seeking to make payments outside our required payment cycle must contact the Finance Office to discuss their proposed plan.

#### Early Payment Discount

An early payment discount of 5% is applicable to the net tuition fee (gross fee less all applicable discounts) if paid in full by 31 March 2023.

#### **External Sibling Discount**

External Sibling Discounts are available for children attending another Catholic Parish Primary School and the form (available from our website) must be returned to the Finance Office by 31 March 2023.

#### School Card Discount or Fee Remissions

A School Card discount of 50% on the net tuition fees is available for approved families. Please refer to our website www.nazareth.org.au/college/finance for further information. Families who receive the school card discount are also eligible to apply for a partial fee remission (based on their financial circumstances.)

Families who do not qualify for School Card but who may have difficulty in meeting the tuition fee payment requirements may apply for a partial fee remission.

The Fee Remission / Fee Reduction Application form is available from the Finance Office or Flinders Park Reception.

#### Who do I contact?

Our Finance staff are located at the Findon Campus (176 Crittenden Road, Findon).

Families may still choose to collect or submit forms and pay their school fees by credit card or EFTPOS at the Flinders Park Campus Reception.

#### **Booking your Learning Conversation**

Each class teacher has nominated the times they are available, and the online booking system, 'School Interviews' will allow you to manage your own bookings. In the majority of cases, where a class has more than one teacher, the Learning Conversation will be with both teachers.

# Year 4 | CyberSafe Families Information Night

On Monday Week 4, Year 4 students and families engaged in Cybersafety workshops with CyberSafe Families.

The Parent/Caregiver session focussed on parental controls among other things. Please see below their key tips/recommendations regarding parental controls.

- iPad controls CyberSafe families recommend using Apple's inbuilt screen time app. There are 3rd party products such as Family Zone and Net Nanny for PC and Android. It is important to remember when it comes to software there is no out of the box solution built to suit one family. All will need customisation and sometimes regular adjustments. There are no set and forget options.
- Gaming consoles such as Xbox and PlayStation have good app supported parental controls.

· Google and other browsers have controls you can use but you will need to create an account to enforce them.

## 7-12 | Athletics Carnival - Postponed

As communicated via email earlier in the week, we would like to remind families:

Due to the hot weather forecast for this week with an expected temperature of 40°C predicted by the Bureau of Meteorology, the decision has been made to postpone our Athletics Carnival that was to be held at SA Athletics Stadium on Friday 24 February. Nazareth takes its duty of care for both students and staff extremely seriously, and to hold a significant event of this size in extreme heat would be considered both thoughtless and negligent. As a result, this Friday will be a normal school day for all staff and Year 7-12 students.

The College has been in dialogue with SA Athletics Stadium about the possibility of moving our Athletics Carnival to a later date, and we are pleased to confirm that the Carnival will now take place on **Wednesday 22 March**.

We understand this date change may be disappointing for our students and staff, but we feel the decision to postpone is the safest option for our community.
