Learning Conversations will take place across Weeks 6 – 8, with the majority of the conversations occurring in Week 7.

Each class teacher has nominated the times they are available, and the online booking system, 'School Interviews' will allow you to manage your own bookings. In the majority of cases, where a class has more than one teacher, the Learning Conversation will be with both teachers.

On Monday Week 4, Year 4 students and families engaged in Cybersafety workshops with CyberSafe Families.

The Parent/Caregiver session focussed on parental controls among other things. Please see below their key tips/recommendations

regarding parental controls.

- iPad controls - CyberSafe families recommend using Apple's inbuilt screen time app. There are 3rd party products such as Family Zone and Net Nanny for PC and Android. It is important to remember when it comes to software there is no out of the box solution built to suit one family. All will need customisation and sometimes regular adjustments. There are no set and forget options.
- Gaming consoles such as Xbox and PlayStation have good app supported parental controls.
- Google and other browsers have controls you can use but you will need to create an account to enforce them.

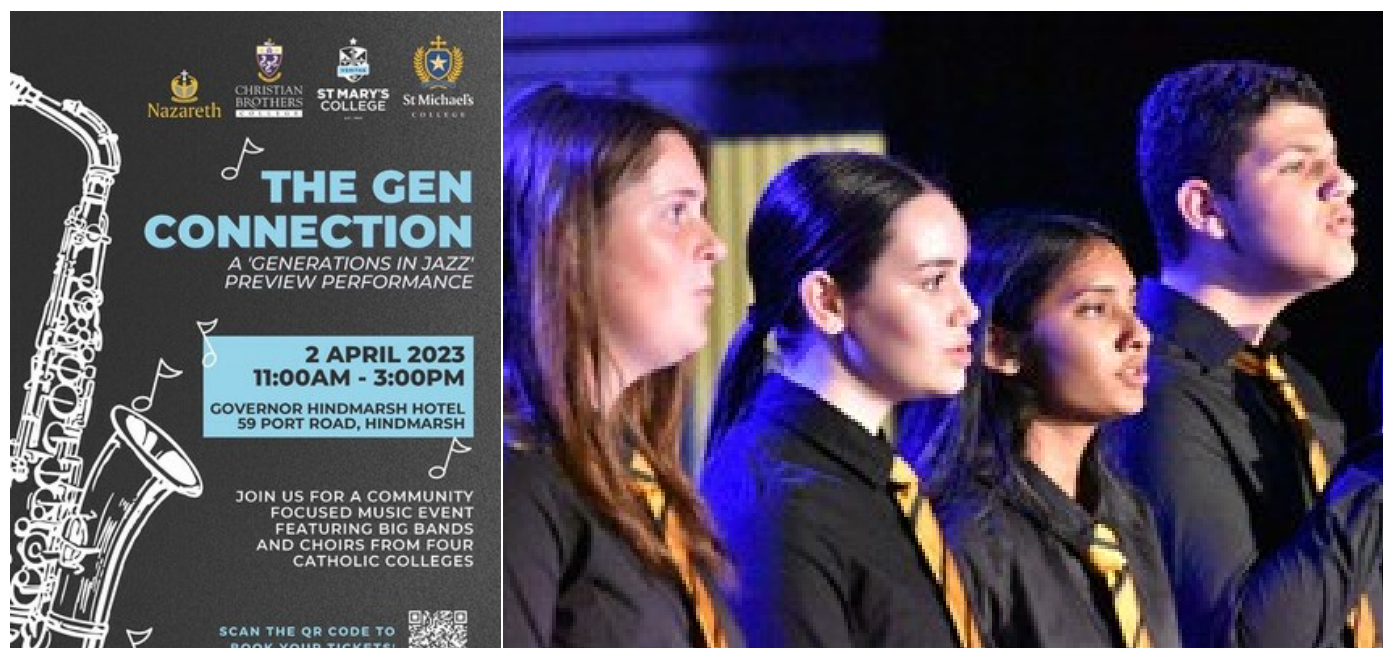
