Solo Performance Schedule 2024

Year 8-12 Elective Music All students undertaking music as an elective subject will perform as a soloist on their instrument or voice. Details are outlined below. All students should liaise with their instrumental tutor regarding appropriate repertoire for their solo performance.

Year 8	Term 3, week 7, Term 4, week 6; Students perform one piece of their standard: 1-2 minutes or as negotiated with music staff.
Year 9	Term 1 + 3, week 7 Term 2 + 4, week 6 Students perform one new piece of their standard: 2-3 minutes per term or as negotiated with music staff
Year 10	Term 1, week 7: 1 piece, approx 2-3 mins Term 2, week 6: 2 pieces, approx 4-6 mins (can include the piece from term 1) Term 3, week 7: 1 piece, minimum 3 mins Term 4, week 3: 2 pieces min, approx. 7-8 mins (can include the piece from term 3)
Year 11	Term 1, week 6: 1 piece, approx 3 mins Term 2, week 6: 2 pieces, approx. 7-8 mins (can include the piece/s from term 1) Term 3, week 6: 1 piece, minimum 5 mins Term 4, week 3: 2 pieces min, approx. 7-8 mins (can include the piece from term 3)
Year 12	Music Explorations Summative 1: Term 1, Week 9
Students requiring accompaniment from year 8- 11 should speak with their music teacher well in advance of the performance date. Piano accompaniment	(4-6 minutes) performance and commentary (500 words) Summative 2: Term 2, Week 7 (4-6 minutes) performance and commentary (500 words) Summative 3: Term 3, Week 8 – Creative Connections (6-8 minutes) 2 or more contrasting pieces + multi-modal discussion
is encouraged. It is the students responsibility to courteously approach their music teacher, and respectfully ask for an accompaniment.	Music Performance – Ensemble or Solo Part testing (2-5 mins) will occur after each public performance for Ensemble. Summative 1: 30% Performance, Term 1, Week 9 (6-8 minutes) 2 or more contrasting pieces Summative 2: 40% Performance + Discussion, Term 2, Week 7
Students who play 2 or more Instruments (ie have tuition on these) should perform on both where practicable, and in consultation with their music teacher. Generally the "best" mark will be used for assessment.
