Dear Year 6 Families







As part of Nazareth Catholic College's Performing Arts program, all Year 6 students have collaborated with the Performing Arts teachers to create an enchanting performance titled 'Worlds of Wonder'. This showcase features a captivating blend of dance, drama, and music as a tour group embarks on a magical adventure.

Your child will be performing in the '**Worlds of Wonder**' on **Wednesday 26 June** at **6pm** in the MacKillop Hall, Findon Campus. All Year 6 students will be involved in rehearsals throughout the day and will perform for the Reception–Year 5 students at 2pm.

The students will remain at school after the regular dismissal time in preparation for the evening performance. Families can order a light Subway meal for \$10 (GST inclusive) paid via Qkr for their child to have at 4pm. This includes a 6-inch sub, cookie and a drink. Alternatively, you can provide extra food for your child to have after school. The evening performance will conclude at approximately 7pm. Students are to be collected from their classrooms after the performance.

<p><b>All Year 6s</b></p> <p>Walk Like An Egyptian Dance</p> <p>Students can wear an Ancient Egyptian inspired costume or accessories for this dance. Where possible, we encourage families to borrow or use items they already have but there are also some fantastic affordable options online.</p> <p>These can include the following items:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>White T-shirt</li> <li>White skirt</li> <li>White pants</li> <li>White dress</li> <li>Neck collar</li> <li>Head piece</li> <li>Bracelets/cuffs</li> <li>Belts</li> <li>Gold trimmings</li> </ul> <p>We have <b>SOME</b> white material, pants and tops, which we can provide to those students who are struggling to find other options. Please talk to your performing arts teachers if you would like to borrow some items for this costume.</p>

- When you receive the Consent2Go, please consent to your child's involvement in both the rehearsal and the performance.

### **Costumes**

- Please bring in any costume items that can remain at school as soon as possible. All costumes will need to be at school by **Wednesday, 12 June**, ready for the dress rehearsal.

### **Tickets**

- Families can purchase tickets from **Wednesday 29 May**, for \$10 each (GST inclusive) through the Qkr App via the following pathway (School Payments > Other Payments > Worlds of Wonder-Year 6 Performance).
- There are 5 tickets available for each family, and families may wish to add their names to the waitlist for additional tickets (see below).
- These tickets will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis once the initial ticket purchase phase has concluded.

- Hair is to be neat, in a ponytail and out of the face.
