Thursday 13th November: Subject Re-Counselling

Students wishing to make changes to subject choices previously submitted are invited to schedule a Re-Counselling session. Students who have chosen subjects deemed not suitable for individual student success, or those who require extra guidance, will be asked to attend a session.

During this session the student and parent/caregiver will meet with a SACE informed leader who will provide guidance to finalise Stage 2 subject choices.

• Monday 17th to Friday 21st November: Examinations

To assist students in developing the skills and necessary expertise, examinations are scheduled for many Stage 1 (Year 11) subjects at the end of each semester. Utilising similar procedures to those undertaken for SACE Stage 2 (Year 12) Examinations, the College provides this type of assessment with the purpose of assessing knowledge and understanding of the coursework, strengthening concepts of organisation and revision, and preparing students for Stage 2 SACE Examinations. Examination results will be recorded on SEQTA and the Semester 2 Report. Please see further details and the examination schedule on the following pages.

• Monday 17th to Friday 21st November: Work Experience

Work experience is a valuable way for students to explore their potential career pathway and is highly encouraged. While work experience can be undertaken at many different points throughout the year, for students without examinations, this week could be an ideal time. • Monday 24th and Tuesday 25th November: Year 11 into 12 Transition Program

To support the transition to Year 12, students will be provided with introductory lessons for their Stage 2 subjects, allowing them to understand the requirements of each subject and get a head start on their studies.

Each timetabled class is staffed by an expert teacher who will introduce students to the subject and begin their learning for Stage 2. Please note that this teacher may not be the allocated teacher for the class next year but is a teacher with subject expertise.

Students will be emailed their allocated subjects for next year, by line, before the Transition Sessions. When students do not have an allocated class, they are expected to be in a study lesson, located in the Hub. Any students with a study session after lunch on Monday 24th are permitted to leave early and are reminded to sign out at Student Services before leaving.

Students are asked to bring materials to support their learning; laptop, note paper, pens etc. A reminder that this is a normal school day and students are expected to wear their correct summer uniform.

Examination Details

WHERE: Examinations will be held upstairs at our Senior Campus at Kidman Park. Students are **only to be at school when they have an examination scheduled**. Students with an examination in sessions 1 and 3, with a break in between, must sign in at Student Services and stay on site. If students are on site at other times, they must also sign in and work silently in the Hub area.

WHEN: The exams will be held from Monday 17th to Friday 21st November. Please see Examination schedule on the next page. All students will have Friday 14th November to use as a study-from-home day in preparation for their exams.

HOW DO STUDENTS PREPARE: Students should check with their teacher(s) about the subject matter that will be examined and the requirements for each examination ie use of a calculator, note sheets, etc. and allocate time during the weeks preceding the examinations specifically for revision.

WHAT TO BRING TO THE EXAM: Students should bring the appropriate equipment for the subject (at least two pens, sharp pencils, ruler, eraser, calculator, etc) in a clear plastic sleeve. Students will not be able to borrow equipment from other students once they have entered the examination room. If required bottled water, glucose lollies and tissues may be brought to the examination.

RULES AND EXPECTATIONS:

- Be in the correct formal uniform for all examinations.
- Expected to arrive at the examination room 10 minutes before the scheduled start of the exam and wait in the café space to be called up.
- Mobile phones, smartwatches, pencil cases, calculator covers, school bags etc. must not be brought into the examination room.
- There will be no student movement during the first and last half an hour of each examination.
 Students are required to remain in the examination room until the allocated time has lapsed.
 Students must not disturb others at any time during the examination; silent conditions will be strictly enforced.
- Absence from any examination will require communication with the College by 9 am on the
 day of the exam. *Unexplained absences* will result in an 'Incomplete' grade recorded and
 a zero result for this assessment. This may impact both the overall SACE grade received for
 the subject and subject choices for next year.
