Dear Year 7-12 Families,

As you would be aware this Monday 23 February we will hold our annual Athletics Carnival at the SA Athletics Stadium. Students will compete in House groups against students in other Houses in a range of formal athletic events. We would like to draw your attention to the following information regarding the organisation, timing, and logistics of the carnival.

To assist with family logistics, we are offering the following modes of travel to and from Athletics Carnival:

- **For Years 7 – 11** they will travel via bus, organised by Nazareth departing from the Flinders Park Campus.
- **Year 12 students** will be **meeting directly at SA Athletics Stadium** (Majorie Jackson-Nelson Dr, Mile End SA 5031) and have their attendance taken by their MG Teacher on site or they have the option to **Travel by Bus from the Flinders Park Campus**.
  - Siblings of Year 12 students only who have been registered via the Year 12 Athletics Consent2 Go will have their attendance recorded accordingly at the Stadium.

*Should your child be travelling privately to Athletics Carnival please read the information below carefully and ensure that you have completed the necessary registration form by no later than **12 noon Thursday 19 February**.*

Please read the information below for each option

#### **Via Bus provided by Nazareth**

- Students will be transported to Athletics Carnival from the Flinders Park Campus via buses provided by Nazareth.
- All buses will leave from the Flinders Park Campus. All buses will also return to the Flinders Park Campus.
- Students are expected to arrive at school at the normal time of 8:40am.
- A reminder that on Monday 23 February the Flinders Park College car park will be closed during drop off and pick up times as there will be buses utilising this space.
- 7-9 students to attend MG for attendance by 8:40am
- 10-11 students to meet in the St Sebastian Centre for attendance by 8:40am
- Yr 12 students not travelling directly to the SA Athletics Stadium will also have their attendance taken in the St Sebastian Centre at 8.40 am. Yr 12 students requiring transport provided by the College must click on the following link: [Register for bus transport](#)
- As always, we encourage families to utilise alternative drop-off and pick-up points in the surrounding streets
- Please note that students will be dismissed from Flinders Park at 2:45pm to assist in the alleviation of traffic. Please note that students will continue to be supervised onsite until our normal duty of care of 3:30pm.
- Torrens Transit and Adelaide Metro buses will run normally.

### **Year 12 Private Travel**

- To assist in family logistics, we are offering the option for siblings of Year 12 students to travel privately to SA Athletics Stadium (Majorie Jackson Nelson Drive, Mile End) via private transport by car or other modes of transport (eg bike, metro bus, walking etc).
- Students travelling privately, will need to arrive promptly at 9.00 am and will be dismissed at 2:45pm.
