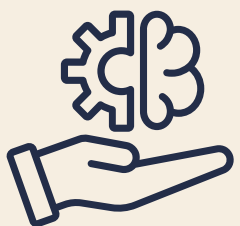


Flinders Enrichment Program

Stream & Workshop Details

STREAM 1 - Bedford Park Campus

ACCOUNTING & COMMERCE [Spin the Wheel](#)

Give the wheel a spin and see where the challenge takes you! Will you crack an Accounting puzzle, make a smart Finance decision, or solve an Economics mystery? Test your skills, compete with friends, and discover how business professionals think, solve problems, and make real-world decisions in this fun, fast-paced interactive game.

CRIMINOLOGY [True Crime. Real Impact.](#)

Learn from SA's largest Criminology team through a hands-on, interactive workshop focused on 'What is Crime? What is Criminology? In this session you will learn collaboratively about crime and deviance, discover how crime is defined, responded to, and experienced by different groups in the community, and why this matters. At Flinders Criminology, you will be empowered to become the change agents needed to have social impact in our community.

GOVERNMENT [War, Climate Change & Rising Inequality](#)

The world's biggest challenges need people who understand them. In this workshop, you'll do what Flinders University politics and international relations students do: get stuck into the debates that shape our world. You might analyse how the media influences democracy, unpack a foreign policy crisis, or argue the case for competing policy responses to real-world problems. These are participatory sessions designed to give you experience of what studying politics and international relations at university feels like (but no background knowledge is required).

LAW [Reading your Mind: Law and the Next Frontier](#)

Should you be able to be convicted if your thoughts are the only evidence of your crime? Should we use brain scans to predict and prevent crime from occurring? Should we track our thoughts and brain activity to keep us safe on the roads? Should we use tech when we study and work to make our brains focus more? What could the law do about all of this???

CREATIVE WRITING & PUBLISHING [Writing & Publishing](#)

Prepare to work as an author, editor, publisher, or researcher with this specialised creative writing workshop. You'll dive into genre fiction, learning from award-winning authors and industry leaders. Our creative writing educators are genre specialists across sci-fi, fantasy, horror, and romance.

SCREEN, FILM & TV [Lights, Camera, Action](#)

Get equipped with an array of skills necessary for a career in screen-based media. This interactive session will provide a hands on experience where you'll get to shoot a short scene and learn to run a film set.

VEED, DIGITAL MEDIA & GAMES [Reach the Top of Your Game](#)

Marvel or DC fans, Fortnite addicts and Pixar lovers, turn your passion into a successful career in the exciting world of Visual Effects, gaming, animation, and Entertainment design. This session will include interactive, hands-on activities, such as motion capture and emerging VR technologies, showcasing the innovative work undertaken at Flinders and in the industry.

STREAM 3 - Bedford Park Campus

EDUCATION [Be an educator who makes a difference](#)

This interactive session explores what it means to be an outstanding educator. Participants are invited to reflect on the best teacher they have ever had and identify the qualities, actions and relationships that made that person so impactful. Through discussion, reflection and the analysis of memorable movie portrayals of teachers in action, the session challenges participants to think deeply about the craft of teaching and the lasting influence educators can have on the lives of students.

LANGUAGES [It's a World of Languages](#)

This session explores how languages coexist, evolve, and influence each other over time. Develop your language and cultural 'antennas' as we engage with the diversity of languages around us.

PSYCHOLOGY [Illusions and Delusions](#)

In this session we guide students through some examples of body ownership and visual illusions (e.g. the rubber hand illusion). Students have the opportunity to conduct experiments that demonstrate these phenomenon, and we will use this experience to guide discussions about what these experiments reveal about the way the human mind and brain works.

SOCIAL WORK [Be the Change](#)

Are you someone who really cares about the well-being of others? Or who gets very frustrated by social inequalities and unfairness? Do you want to help be the voice for the voiceless or help empower them to be heard and supported? Then Social Work is right for you! Social Workers work in many different settings where they help to promote meaningful changes for individuals, families and communities. Come check out our workshop and see how social work can help you be the change!

STREAM 4 - Bedford Park Campus

BIODIVERSITY & CONSERVATION [Burrowing spiders & scorpions](#)

Discover the hidden world beneath your feet! This session explores spiders and scorpions of conservation significance in South Australia, with a focus on the fascinating biology of burrowing species and how they survive and hunt. Students will then get hands-on, using a videoscope to explore real and artificial spider burrows, and will have the chance to safely observe live burrowing scorpions and trapdoor spiders up close.

ROBOTICS [Zumo Pursuit Challenge : Race, Tune, Optimise!](#)

Can your Zumo robot become the ultimate pursuer? In this head-to-head challenge, two Zumos race on parallel tracks, navigating corners and obstacles while chasing each other. Students learn line-following by tuning sensors and adjusting speed. Beginners focus on calibration and basic tracking, while advanced users explore optimisation like dynamic speed control.

ENGINEERING [Drive Tomorrow's Innovations](#)

With fully accredited Engineering degrees across Biomedical, Civil, Electrical and Electronic, Environmental, Maritime, Mechanical, Nuclear, Robotics and Software specialisations, learn how Flinders will prepare you to solve problems and build solutions in areas such as climate change, autonomous vehicles, space exploration, healthcare and secure communications.
