R-6 SPORTS DAY – FRIDAY 30 OCTOBER

We are excited to be holding our R-6 Sports Day on the oval at the Flinders Park Campus once again. This is a fantastic opportunity to utilise our Nazareth facilities. Please take the time to read this information carefully so that the day is a great success for all. We look forward to seeing you there.

EVENT LOCATION

Flinders Park Campus Oval – 1 Hartley Road, Flinders Park

TIMING & LOGISTICS

8:30am - 9:15am	Students are to be dropped off at the Finders Park Campus between 8:30am and 9:15am. If you choose to utilise the Kiss and Drop, staff will be there to accompany your child to the Gym where they will meet their class teacher. We ask that families refrain from going into the Gym during this time, as we gather all students into their class groups. OSHC (Before School Care 7am – 8:30am) will be operating as per normal at the Findon Campus. Families can book through the normal process using Extend and students will be transported to the Flinders Park Campus from 8:30am by school bus.
9:15am	Students assemble on the oval under their House tent.
9:30am	Official Opening: House Chant, Hustle, Opening Speeches etc.
10:00am	Station Rotations Commence (Recess at 10:45am)
12noon - 12.30pm	Lunch
12:30pm - 1:00pm	Boys and Girls Championship Races (2 x students from each house per race)
1:00pm - 1:15pm	Presentations and conclusion of the day.
1:15pm - 1:35pm	Students can depart with their parent / caregiver. ALL students MUST be signed out by their class teacher.
1:35pm - 3:10pm	Students who do not depart by 1:35pm will move to the Performing Arts Space (PAS) where they will be supervised by staff. This includes OSHC students. A snack will be provided.
3:10pm - 3:30pm	Remaining students to be picked up from the PAS.
3:10pm	Students booked into OSHC will return to the Findon Campus by school bus.
3:30pm – 6pm	OSHC students to be collected from the Findon Campus.

PICK UP

To manage traffic and supervision at the Flinders Park Campus, students can:

Be signed out by a family member from the class teacher at the conclusion of Sports Day, between 1:15pm - 1:35pm OR

Remain at the Flinders Park Campus in supervised care until the end of what would be a normal school day, and collected from the Flinders Park Campus between 3:10pm – 3:30pm OR

Attend OSHC (After School Care 3:30pm – 6pm) at the Findon Campus. Families can book through the normal process using Extend. OSHC students will be transported via school bus from the Flinders Park Campus to the Findon Campus at 3:10pm and supervised as normal.

OSHC REMINDER

Please ensure you mark your child absent if they will not be attending before or after school care as normal. If your child is not marked absent and does not attend OSHC you will be charged accordingly.

STUDENT INFORMATION

Students are required to wear a House-coloured t-shirt with their Nazareth sports shorts and Nazareth hat (please ensure this is labelled).

Coloured zinc and / or coloured hair spray can be applied at home but must not be brought to Sports Day.

Please note that only Year 6 students can wear other items in their House colour, as directed by Mr Antoniadis. The Nazareth bucket hat or broad brim hat must be worn by all Year 6 students.

Students need to have sunscreen applied at home. There will be sunscreen available for students to reapply throughout the day.

Students need to bring their lunch in a labelled **disposable** bag that will be placed in a cool room. Fruit will be provided for recess to all students. No lunchboxes or school bags should be brought to school.

Students need to bring a labelled water bottle. There will be water available for students to refill drink bottles throughout the day.



PARKING

The main car park will be available, with limited parking. Once this car park is full, we ask that all spectators park in the surrounding streets, observing any parking restrictions and respecting the local residents' access to their homes.

ENTRY

Entry to the oval for all spectators will be through the Hartley Road main pedestrian gate. We ask that no spectators enter the campus via the roadway / driveway.

TOILETS

Students will have designated toilets within the St Cecilia building. These will be clearly signed.

All spectators will have access to the toilets via the changerooms adjoined to the maintenance sheds. These will also be clearly signposted.

FOOD / DRINK

We ask that students come prepared with food for the day, as per the information above.

It is important to note that there will be no canteen facilities available for students.

Some food & beverage options will be available on the day for spectators to purchase on the oval.

Please do not purchase spectator food for students.

SPECTATOR AREAS

There will be designated spectator areas across the oval and we ask that you keep to these areas to allow the students to fully participate in their activities. Feel free to bring a chair or picnic rug.
