Administering the Survey

Effective administration of the LLL Surveys helps maximise participation rates and ensures a more accurate reflection of staff perceptions and experiences. The guidance detailed in the Administration Guide, and summarised below, is designed to support consistent administration across schools.

Key Administration Considerations

- Actively promote the survey before the administration period begins.
- Provide parents and caregivers with the survey link or QR code, together with the appropriate access code.
- Send at least two reminder communications during the administration period, including survey access details.
- Use a range of communication methods to promote participation, such as newsletters, social media, school apps, text messages, and email.
- Encourage participation by highlighting the importance of parent and caregiver feedback in supporting school improvement.
- Refer to the Administration Guide for further information.

Information to Share with Parents and Caregiver Prior to Survey Administration

Before parents and caregivers complete the survey, schools are encouraged to communicate the information below. A sample letter is provided and may be adapted to suit the school's context.

- The survey takes approximately 3–5 minutes to complete.
- The purpose of the survey is to gather parents' and caregivers' perceptions of the school's performance.
- The survey provides an important opportunity for parents and caregivers to share their experiences and perspectives about the school and their child's education.
- The school values parent and caregiver feedback and will use survey responses to inform ongoing improvement efforts.
- Individual responses are confidential and are never shared with the school. Results are reported only in aggregated form, and no results are reported for groups containing fewer than four respondents.
- Parents and caregivers are encouraged to respond honestly. There are no right or wrong answers.
- Parents and caregivers with more than one child enrolled at the school should respond with their oldest child's experience in mind.
- Responses are recorded on a six-point scale, where 1 represents the lowest rating and 6 represents the highest rating.

A sample letter to parents and caregivers is provided below. Schools may adapt this communication to suit their context.
